

Monday, June 6, 2016 Monthly Meeting - Secretaries Report

7:30 p.m. - Meeting called to order

Board members in attendance: President Mark Patterson, Vice-President Andrew Zachary, Treasurer Brian Jannert, Chief Range Safety Officer Jim Uffner and Secretary Laura Lucker

Meeting opened with The Pledge of Allegiance recited by the membership in attendance.

Following the reading of the Secretaries Report, it was noted that the section read containing information about the update to the Tolsma Challenge was incorrectly recorded, corrections were made. There was motion to accept the report with the noted corrections, seconded and approved by the members in attendance.

Following the reading of the Treasures Report,

. There was a motion to accept the report as read, seconded and approved by the members in attendance.

Following the reading of the Chief Range Safety Officers report, a vote was asked to approve 10 new applications for new membership, which were approved by the membership in attendance.

Old Business: ***During the spring clean-up of the backstop area, the sand removal has been lower to a level whereas bullets are able to pass through a gap in the back. Maintenance is needed on the back stop along with rubber replacement.***Bryan Dixon gave the members an update on the latest IDPA class and announced he has scheduled the next IDPA class for Saturday June 12th.***Neil Hays's request to purchase a second gun safe for the range guns, was approved with a budget of \$400.00. The new safe should be in place by our next scheduled meeting in July.***As we are looking to improve the sound defying materials in the attic, Brian Jannert has volunteer to contact Flagel Insulation to request a quote to improve the insulation in the clubs attic space.*** The interest in a target positioning system, temporary stands, or retrieval systems was once again opened for discussion. Neil Hays and Mark Patterson brought up several maintenance issues and safety concerns. The target turning system is in need of repairs and backstop improvements would need to be address prior to moving forward with any new targeting system. They are hopeful that we could provide the club with an update on this project within 8 to 10 weeks. ***We have scheduled our first club sponsored Ladies Night education event. The event would consist of 2 hours of classroom time along with the introduction and use of a small caliber hand gun on the range. The first class has been scheduled for Thursday July 14, 2016 from 7:00 to 9:00. Cost will be \$20.00 for members/spouses and \$30.00 for non-members.

New Business: *** Mark Patterson asked members to think of an incentive, such as membership due discounts for services rendered, that would encourage club members to step up and help out with daily clean-up needs, along with club house, range and lawn maintenance requirements needed throughout the year. There is currently a suggested list of cleaning needs posted in the club house. Members were asked to help out, by visiting the club house and completing a task or two on that list. ***Andrew Zachary asked the membership to consider having two CPL classes per month. One of which would be held on a Saturday during the month and other to be held on a Sunday. Along with members expressing that their schedule does not always allow for a set Saturday or Sunday class, this would also keep from closing the club two Saturdays a month for CPL classes. With The approval of the members in attendance, Andrew Zachary will update the clubs website calendar to reflect these changes***


