7:28 p.m. - Meeting called to order.

The motion was seconded and approved by the members in attendance.


Announcements: *** We will be looking to schedule a date for our Spring Cleaning sometime in April or May.

As always, check the clubs website for updates and for upcoming calendar of events.


Adjournment: A motion was entered to adjourn the monthly meeting, seconded and approved by the members in attendance.
