Material has been purchased to fabricate the next ceiling baffle and once complete, it will be determined if a third ceiling baffle would be needed. As more information about this project becomes available it will be presented to the members.

New Business: ***A complaint was filed with the Lincoln Township Police, by our adjoining neighbor, about the noise (gun fire) coming from the club after 11:00 p.m. At this time, the Officer responding to the complaint has been in contact with Zach Hays and it was noted by the Officer that they have not had a complaint like this in the past. Members were asked to consider refraining from late night shooting. However, GMRPC is a 24/7 facility and the Club is not about to restrict the hours at which we visit the club and the neighbors are aware of this.

New member applications: ***There were no new applications presented for membership.


