

Monday, April 2, 2018 Monthly Meeting Minutes

7:28 p.m. - Meeting called to order.

Upon completion of the club orientation and on the recommendation of the Chief Range Safety Officer, new applicant approval will be put to a vote at the next scheduled club meeting.


